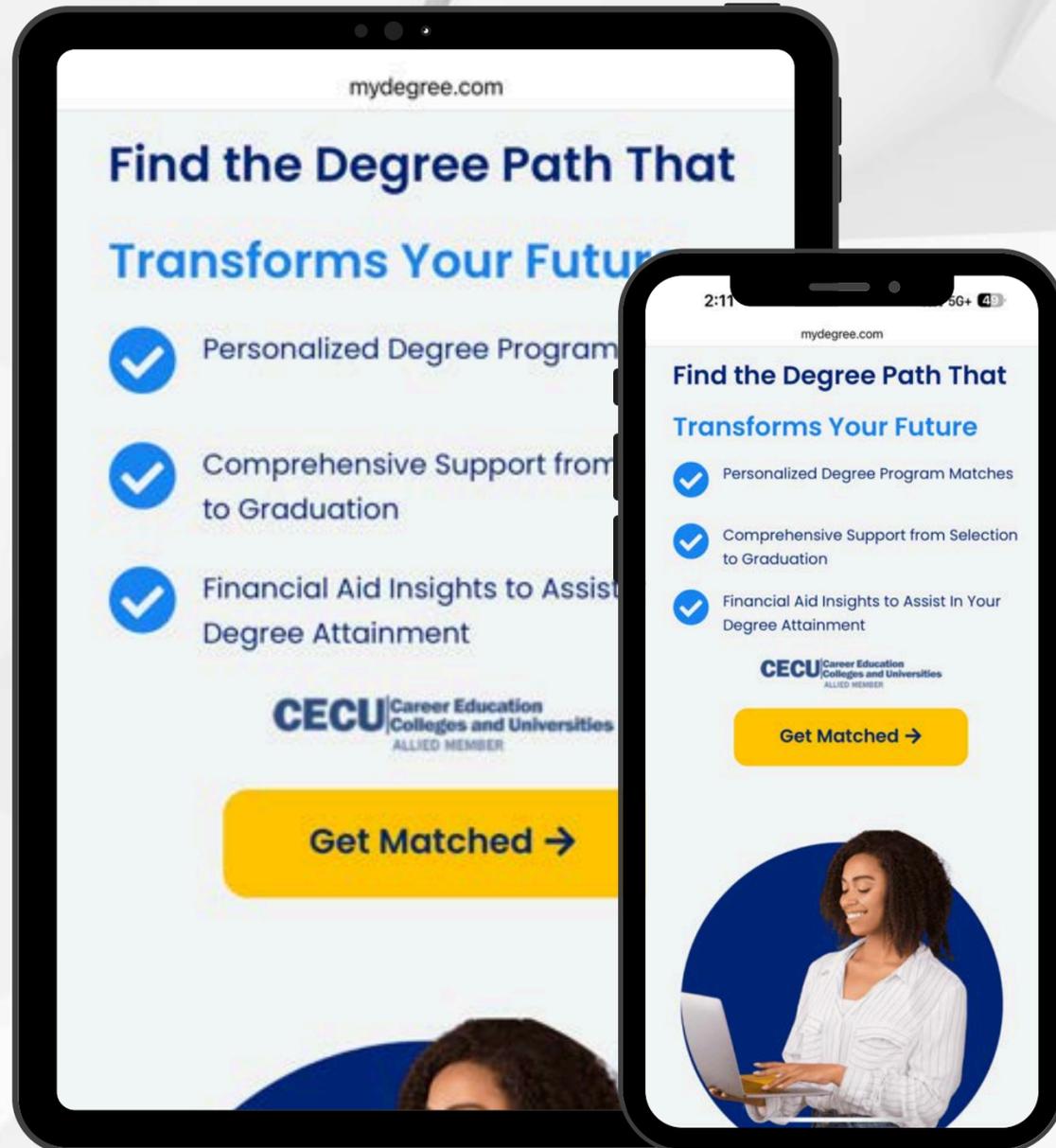

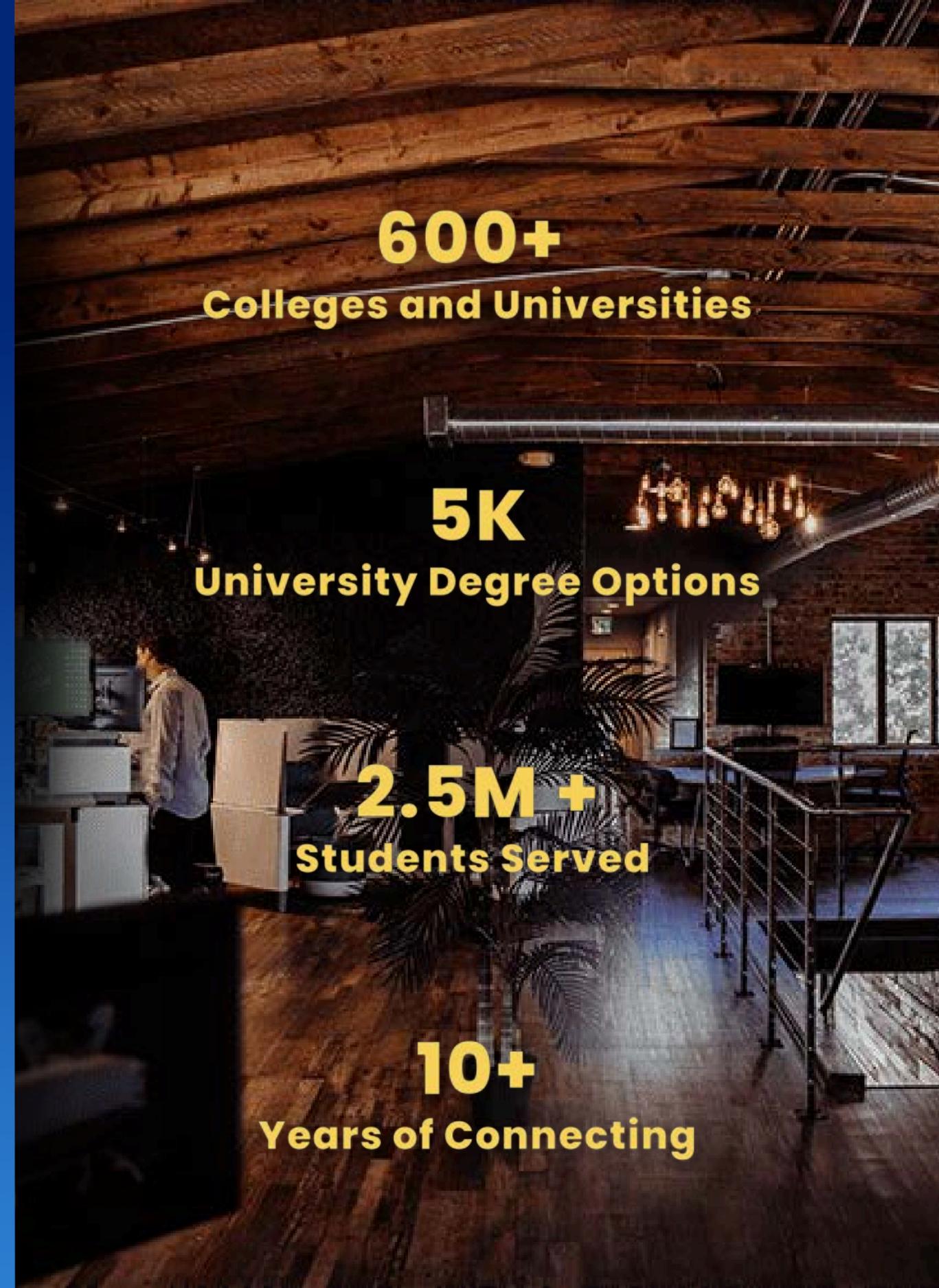

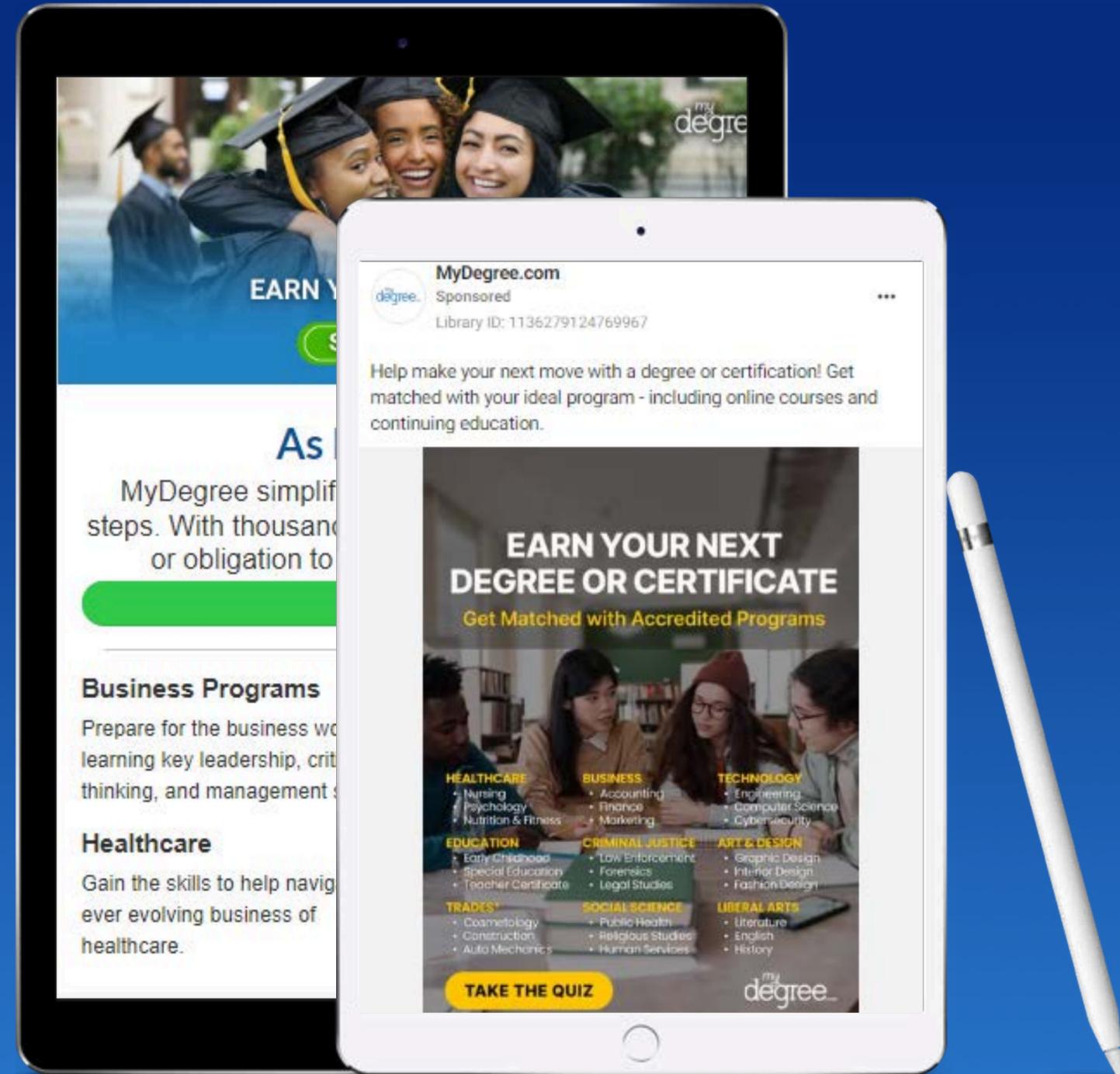

# REFERENCING GUIDELINES

At MyDegree, we ensure all advertising and creative materials adhere to strict compliance standards to maintain trust and transparency with prospective students. When referencing financial aid or career-related outcomes, it is crucial to follow these guidelines to avoid misleading claims and ensure accuracy.

## Financial Aid Statements

- **Always** use conditional language when discussing financial aid.
- **Always** include a source citation e.g., the Student Aid website. <https://studentaid.gov/understand-aid/types/grants/pell>

### Examples:

- ✓ Financial aid may be available if you qualify.\*
- ✓ You may apply for up to \$7,395 in financial aid if you qualify.\*
- ✗ Financial aid is guaranteed.
- ✗ Get free money.

## Job and Career Outcome Statements

- **Avoid** definitive promises about employment or salary outcomes.
- **Always** reference credible data when discussing career opportunities. <https://www.bls.gov/>

### Examples:

- ✓ Graduates may pursue careers in [industry] with opportunities for growth. Employment figures are based on national averages and may vary by location\*.
- ✗ Your degree will guarantee you a high-paying job.

## General Referencing Rules

- Ensure all data cited is from reputable sources, such as government organizations (e.g., BLS or O\*NET) and is no more than two years old.
- Avoid making unverified quality claims (e.g., "the best programs") or misleading comparisons without citing independent rankings.
- Use neutral and factual language when presenting program benefits to remain clear, fair, and compliant.

# THE APPROVED COLOR PALETTE

## Primary Colors

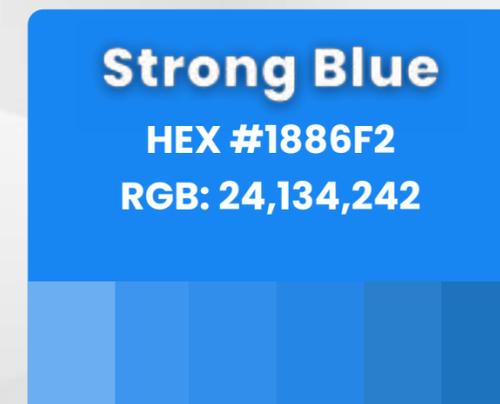


This is the primary color for the MyDegree logo and should be used for prominent elements, such as headlines, buttons, or other focal points that need to stand out.

## **Usage Guidelines:**

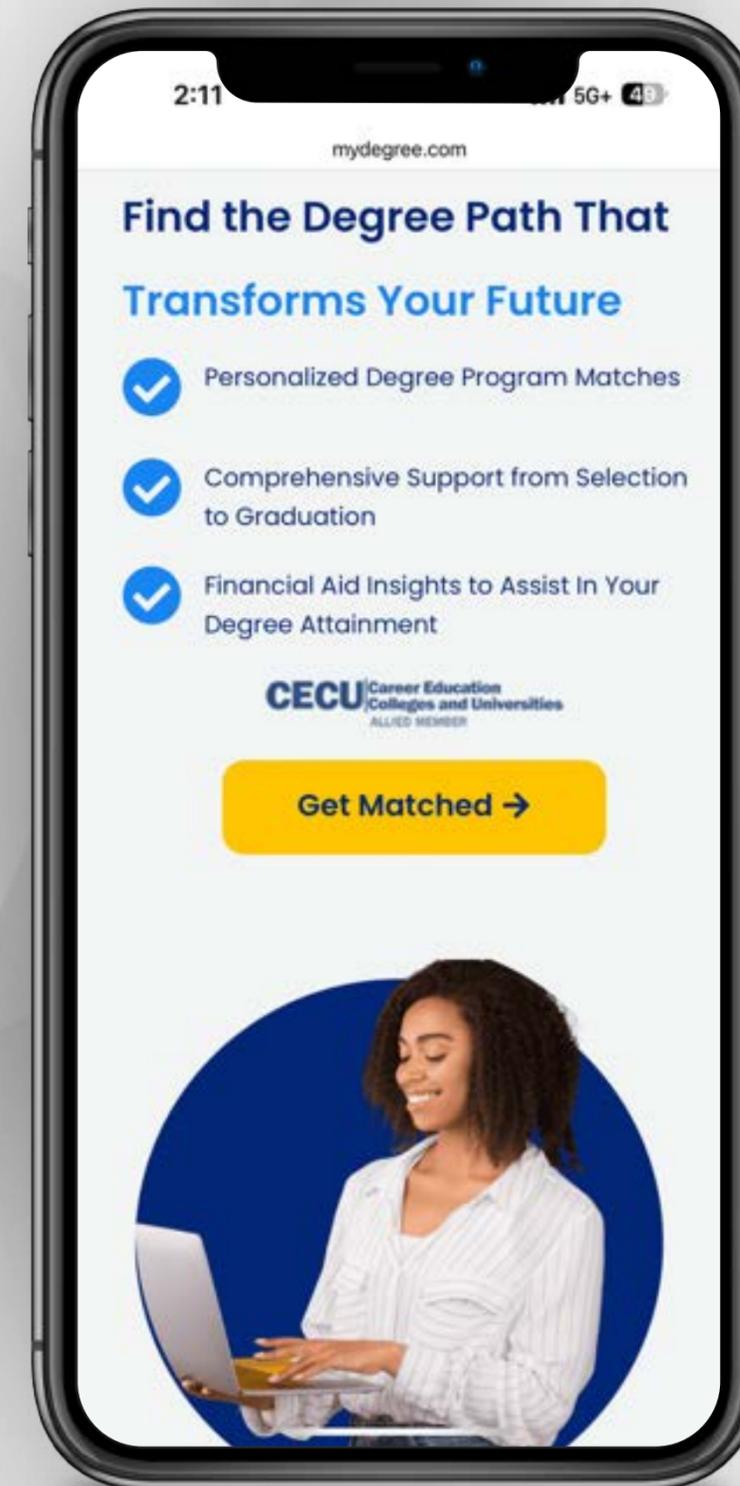
- Always maintain clear space around the logo equivalent to the height of the "M" in MyDegree.
